Postgraduate Certificate in Professional Supervision

This qualification will equip you with the knowledge and skills to foster reflective practice and support professional practice relationships.

- Created for professionals from across the human services, including health, social services, HR and education
- One-year, part-time programme
- Blends a series of two-day, face-to-face classes on campus with online teaching and learning

The programme encompasses two, 30-credit courses. In the first course (Foundations of Supervision, PGPS801) you'll examine established principles of professional supervision and engage in skills workshops. In the second course (Developing Supervision Practice, PGPS802) you'll apply your knowledge and skills to your own supervisory practice.

Note: Developing Supervision Practice can only be undertaken once you've passed all components of Foundations of Supervision.
